# No-Sew Blanket

## Materials

- 1.5 yards fleece fabric—solid or prints suitable for adults; fabric in neutral colors to be used for men or women
- Scissors

## Instructions

1. Fold the fabric in half, selvage (finished edge of fabric) to selvage. Always cut through both layers of fabric.



2. Trim off selvage.
3. Trim the short ends so that the fabric is an even rectangle.
4. With fabric still folded, cut a 3"x3" square out of the 2 selvage-edge corners (DO NOT cut corners on the folded edge).



5. With fabric still folded, cut fringes into the cut edges of the fabric. Fringes should measure 1" wide by 3" long. DO NOT cut the folded edge.
